2. These Petitions are filed for quashing the subject F.I.R. by consent. Petitioners in Writ Petition No.626 of 2015 and Writ Petition No.627 of 2015 had earlier filed Writ Petition No.3293 of 2014 and Writ Petition No.3294 of 2014 respectively for quashing the same F.I.R. by consent.
