Ms. Bharucha, the learned counsel for respondent nos.2 to 4 states that since the National Defence Academy is a part of the Defence Ministry of the Government of India and the petitioner is a civilian, the writ petition would not lie before this Court and that the petitioner will have to approach the Central Administrative Tribunal at Mumbai.

2 In view of the above, this writ petition is dismissed as not maintainable but the petitioner is granted liberty to move the Central Administrative Tribunal.
