. Heard the learned counsel for the applicants, the learned APP for the respondent – State and the learned counsel for the intervener.

2. The learned counsel for the applicants seeks by way of indulgence one last chance to deposit the balance amount of Rs.10,30,000/- within two weeks from today. This Court was

not inclined on merits to entertain this application. However, only in view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the applicants on the instructions of the applicants that she is ready to deposit the said amount, that interim protection was granted.
