taken instructions from the concerned officer states that the learned Commissioner of Police, Bombay directed Police Inspector Administration MIDC Police Station, Bombay to hold enquiry in regard to petitioner's grievance made in the said complaint and accordingly, enquiry was conducted and it was found that petitioner's grievance is without any substance. The learned APP placed for our perusal report of the Police Inspector Administration MIDC Police Station dated 21.4.2015.
