2. This is an application for condonation of delay of 128 days in filing Second Appeal. Office remark shows that respondents no. 3B to 3F, 4A to 4C are served. Respondent no.3A has died leaving behind respondent no.3B as legal

representative of respondent no.3A.

3. For the reasons stated in the application which are not controverted, I am satisfied that the applicants have made out sufficient cause for condoning the delay.
