- 1 Not on board. At the request of Advocate for the appellant, matter is taken on board for urgent orders.
- 2 This application is preferred by plaintiff for condonation of one day delay in filing Appeal from Order challenging the order dt.24.2.2015 passed by Bombay City Civil Court, Mumbai in Notice of Motion No.789 of 2015 in Suit No.444 of 2015 declining to grant ad-interim relief in favour of plaintiff.
