4 This application is preferred by defendant no.12 for condonation of 1 year and 330 days delay in filing Appeal from Order.

5 Considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the applicant and averments made in civil application particularly in paragraph 4, I am satisfied that applicant has made out the case for allowing the civil application.

6 Hence, civil application is allowed in terms of prayer clause (b), which reads thus:

“b) This Hon'ble Court be pleased to condoned the delay of 1 year 330 days in filing the Appeal from Order.”

7 Office is directed to make appropriate noting in cause title of Appeal from Order that Appeal from Order stands dismissed against respondent nos.6, 7, 9, 10 and 13.
