This appeal is preferred by Defendant Nos.1 and 2 challenging the order dated 02/02/2015 passed by the Bombay City Civil Court, Mumbai in Notice of Motion No.40/2012 appointing Court Receiver in respect of the property described at Sr.No.1 of Annexure-C of the plaint.
