2. This is a petition for quashing the private complaint cases pending against the petitioners in the court of Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, 2nd Court, Mazagaon. It appears that the dispute between the petitioners (accused) and respondent no. 1 (complainant) has been resolved amicably. Learned counsel for respondent no. 1 has submitted that he has been

instructed by respondent no. 1 to resolve the dispute amicably and that respondent no. 1 has no objection if the proceedings pending against the petitioner in the court of Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, 2nd Court, Mazgaon are quashed.
