2. This application is moved for relaxation of condition No.(iii) pertaining to attendance in para 4 of the order dated 1.8.2014 in Anticipatory Bail Application No.914 of 2014. The learned Counsel for the applicant/accused submits that the applicant/accused was directed to attend the concerned police station on every Monday and every Friday between 6pm to 7pm, till filing of chargesheet.
