2. The learned counsel appearing for the appellants and the learned counsel appearing for the first to third respondents tender Consent Terms of today's date. The learned counsel appearing for the appellants states that the Consent Terms have been signed by Shri S. Raghavendra Rao, Manager of the appellants.
