1. Heard learned counsel for the Applicant and the learned APP for the Respondent – State.
2. By this application, the applicant seeks Transit Anticipatory Bail for a period of six weeks.
3. The applicant is apprehending arrest in connection with C.R.No.168 of 2009, which is registered with the Chikkajajur Police Station, Chitradurga, State – Karnataka, subsequently transferred to the Special Investigation Team, Lokayukta, Bangalore, for the alleged offences
