1. Heard. The petitioner is challenging an order externing him under the provisions of Section 56 (1)(A) (B) of the Bombay Police Act. Mr. Killedar, learned Counsel for the petitioner does not dispute that against the said order, an appeal is maintainable under Section 60 of the Bombay Police Act. We are, therefore, not inclined to entertain the present petition.

2. However, the Petitioner is at liberty to challenge the order by filing an appeal before the appropriate authority.
