1 After the petition was partly argued, both the counsel agree that the Complaint No. NTB-4 of 2003 needs to be remanded to the National Industrial Tribunal for fresh hearing. Complaint No.NTB-4 of 2003 is remanded to the National Industrial Tribunal, Mumbai for fresh hearing. evidence thereafter hear the parties and decide the Reference. The parties shall appear before the Tribunal on 17th August, 2015.
