2. Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and learned APP for Respondent No.2-State.

The Petitioner challenges the order passed by learned Sessions Judge in Criminal Appeal No.401 of 2014 directing the Petitioner to pay interim maintenance of Rs.1,000/-p.m. to Respondent No.1 i.e. his wife. The Petitioner was earlier directed to pay Rs.2,000/- p.m. to Respondent No.1 by the order of the Magistrate. Order of the Magistrate has been modified by the learned

Sessions Judge and in my opinion there is no scope for interference in the said order as it is an interim order and moreover amount of Rs.1,000/- is not a huge amount, which could be reconsidered again.

4. The criminal writ petition stands dismissed summarily.
