3 The substantive sentence imposed on the applicant shall remain suspended during the pendency of the revision application.

4 The Applicants shall deposit Rs.2,50,000/- in the trial court within a period of 10 days from today.

5 If the said amount of Rs.2,50,000/- is not deposited within the period of 10 days from today, the bail order shall stand revoked. The learned Magistrate shall take necessary steps to arrest the applicant and send him to prison for undergoing sentence.

sentence shall stand disposed of in the above terms.
