1. Heard arguments on the application for bail during pendency of the appeal.
2. During the trial, the applicant/appellant was on bail. He was convicted for the offences punishable under Sections 7, 13(1)(d) read with Section 13(2) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988. On each count he was sentenced to

suffer RI for one year and fine of Rs.2000/- each. Reportedly, the fine amount has already been paid.

Considering the case against the applicant/appellant and considering that it will take much time to conclude the appeal finally, the applicant be released on same bail as granted by the trial Court with fresh bonds to be executed before the trial Court. Application for bail is disposed of accordingly.
