. Heard learned counsel appearing for the Applicants and the learned counsel appearing for the first and second Respondents. It is not in dispute that the Application for temporary injunction made by the Applicants during the pendency of the suit was rejected by the Trial Court and the said order was confirmed by the learned Single Judge of this Court in Appeal No.188 of 2012.
