2. This Application is preferred by the opponent No.2 for condonation of 142 days delay in filing the First Appeal challenging the impugned judgment and award dated 08/01/2013 passed by the Commissioner for Workmen's Compensation at Kolhapur in WC.NO.21/B-3/2011.

3. The learned counsel for the Respondent No.7 vehemently opposed the Civil Application. He submits that the Applicant has not shown sufficient cause for condonation of delay. There is

no substance in the Civil Application. Same be dismissed with costs.

4. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the Applicant and the averments made in the Application, I am satisfied that the Applicant has made out a case for allowing the present Civil Application.

5. Hence, the following order:

- a) Delay of 142 days in preferring the First Appeal is condoned.
- b) Civil Application stands disposed off accordingly.
- c) Place the First Appeal (ST) No.9270/2014 on board along with the present appeal.
