Mr. Singh submitted that in paragraph 7 of the impugned order, the learned trial Judge observed that if the petitioner-plaintiff feels that the amendment carried out by him is mistaken or otherwise, he is required to take appropriate steps in that regard. In the light of this observation, plaintiff will take out appropriate proceedings in that regard and he, therefore, does not press this Petition.

4. In view thereof, Petition is disposed of as not pressed with the liberty to the respondents to raise all contentions that are available in case petitioner-plaintiff takes out appropriate proceedings.
