1. Heard Mrs.Gajare, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the applicant/State. Heard Mr.Kendre, who appears for the respondents. He submits that Mr.Gole who appears for the respondents is not well and that, therefore, the matter be adjourned.

2. However, I find that the question is only of granting of leave to file an appeal. Hearing the respondent is not essential before deciding the question of grant of leave. In view of this, I am not inclined to adjourn the matter.

3. After hearing the learned APP and after going through the relevant parts of the impugned Judgment, I think it fit to grant leave as sought for.
4. Leave granted.
5. The application for leave to appeal be treated as a memo of appeal and be numbered accordingly. Necessary amendments be carried out within two weeks.
6. Appeal is admitted.
7. Action under Section 390 of the Code of Criminal Procedure be taken against the respondents by issuing bailable warrant in the sum of Rs.5,000/- each, against them.
8. Hearing of the appeal is ordered to be expedited.
