1. Heard Mr. Naik, learned Counsel for the petitioner and Mrs. Kejriwal, learned APP for the respondent State. By this petition, the petitioner is seeking direction to respondent no.1 to register the FIR.

2. One Mr. Nilkanth Bagale, API, Kopri Police Station has filed an affidavit dated 31.10.2014. The affidavit discloses that the

petitioner's complaint was inquired with and thereafter it was found that the cognizable offence is not made out. The petitioner is accordingly informed by communication dated 29.10.2014.
