1. Heard learned Counsel for the respective parties.
2. The Writ Petition No.3171 of 2014 is filed for quashing of FIR No.I-130 of 2014 registered with Kamothe Police Station, Navi Mumbai. The Criminal Writ Petition No.4340 of 2014 is filed for transfer of investigation of this case to the EOW, Mumbai.
