2. This petition challenges the order dated 03/06/2014 by which the interim maintenance has been denied to the petitioner. However, it would be appropriate if directions are issued to the Family Court at Bandra to dispose of Petition No.A-1272 of 2012 as expeditiously as possible and in any case, within a period of six months from the date of production of authenticated copy of this order. not permit itself to be influenced by any observations made in the impugned order as well as the factum of non-entertainment of the present petition. The main petition to be decided on its own merits and in accordance with law.
