2 Perused the FIR bearing No.I 81 of 2014 dated 15.3.2014 registered with Navghar Police Station, Bhayander, Thane, which discloses commission of offence under the provisions of Sections 498-A, 323, 504 and 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860. We are, therefore, not inclined to quash the FIR. Petition is devoid of any merit and, therefore, the same is, accordingly, dismissed.
