7. The petitioners, including, the newly added petitioners are present in the Court. So also Mr. Kamal Khaitan, the representative of Respondent no.4 is present in the Court. The petitioners as well as the representative of Respondent no.4 state that they have signed the consent terms by their own free will and after understanding the scope and import thereof. The parties have been identified by their respective advocates who have also signed upon the consent terms.

8. The extract of the resolution passed at the meeting of Board of Directors of respondent no.4 authorizing Mr. Kamal Khaitan to sign the consent terms is also produced on record (Copy is produced on record).
