Perused the contents of the application. Also perused the judgment and award passed by the Reference Court. In the facts of the case, the award is stayed during the pendency of the First Appeal, as the applicant has deposited the entire decretal amount in the Reference Court.

In the facts of the case, the respondents are permitted to withdraw 75% of the deposited amount on furnishing solvent surety/security to the satisfaction of the Reference Court. The balance amount may be

deposited in a Fixed Deposit account of a nationalized bank initially for a period of three years and the said account should be renewed from time to time during the pendency of the First Appeal.

Civil Application is allowed in the aforesaid terms and disposed of.
