1 Heard Shri Prashant Gurav, the learned counsel for the applicant / appellant.

2 It was decided that the appeal itself should be heard and finally decided, and as such, the present application for suspension of sentence was kept pending.

3           The learned counsel for the applicant / appellant, however, submits that, the hearing of the appeal be deferred till 14<sup>th</sup> December 2015. The Office note shows that amendment has not been carried out in accordance with the order dated 26<sup>th</sup> October 2015.

4           Under the circumstances, though I am inclined to defer the hearing of the appeal, as prayed for by the learned counsel for the applicant / appellant, I am not inclined to keep the application for suspension of sentence pending.

5           Upon going through the evidence recorded during the trial, and the fact that the applicant / appellant had withdrawn his application for suspension of sentence that had been filed previously, I do not think it fit to suspend the sentence imposed upon the applicant / appellant.

6           The application is rejected.
