1] The learned counsel for the respondent no. 4 hands over to the learned counsel for the petitioners cheques towards rent in lieu of transit accommodation, which the respondent no. 4 was required to pay to the petitioners in terms of this Court's order dated 6 March 2014 in writ petition no. 11757 of 2013. With this, the grievance with regard to non payment of rent in lieu of transit accommodation, does not survive.

2] The learned counsels for the respondent nos. 3 and 4 state that consistent with their statement as recorded in the order dated 6 March 2014 in writ petition no. 11757 of 2013, the said respondents shall execute necessary agreements with the

petitioners. The learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners will approach the respondent no. 4 on 16 March 2015 at 11.00 a.m., so as to facilitate the execution of agreements on the said date.

3] The learned counsel for the respondent no. 4 further states that pay orders in respect of rent in lieu of transit accommodation payable to the petitioners had been handed over by the respondent no. 4 to the respondent no. 2. In view of the payments made today, by the respondent no. 4 to the petitioners, the respondent no. 2 is directed to return the said pay orders to the respondent no. 4.

4] With this, nothing further survives in this petition, which is disposed of.
