- 1] Not on board. Upon production, taken on board.
- 2] There is no case made out to interfere with the impugned order, at this stage. The evidence of landlord is complete. The Petitioner is also examined himself and the matter is kept for examination of further defence witnesses. In fact, the matter is fixed on 5 November 2015 for the said purpose. If, however, the suit is ultimately decided against the Petitioner, the Petitioner shall have liberty to challenge the order declining leave to amend alongwith substantive appeal, which he may chose to institute.
