1 Heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties.

2 The learned counsel for the parties pray that the learned Magistrate be directed for hearing of the criminal case filed by the petitioner against the respondents as expeditiously as possible.

3 It is directed that the learned Magistrate shall take up the case on 21st February, 2015 (which is the date already given to the parties) for explaining particulars of the offence to
