1. By this application, the applicant is seeking interim protection, till the final disposal of her Anticipatory Bail Application, which is pending before the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Greater Bombay. It appears that vide order dated 16th October, 2015, the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Greater Bombay has rejected the applicant's prayer for interim protection and notice was issued making the same returnable on

6. In view of the aforesaid order, the learned Senior Counsel for

the applicant does not press this application at this stage.

7. The Application is disposed of in above terms.
