2. By this application, the applicant seeks
transit anticipatory bail in connection with
C.R.No.96 of 2012 registered with the Rama
Police Station, State – Punjab & Haryana, for
the alleged offence punishable under Section
420 r/w.34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that he may be granted transit anticipatory bail for a period of four weeks to enable him to approach the appropriate Court for seeking appropriate reliefs.
