Mr. Ponda, learned Counsel appearing for the Petitioner having taken instructions from his client seeks leave to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to challenge the notice dated 20th October 2015, copy of which is annexed at Exhibit-A to the petition, before the appellate authority in New Delhi.
