1. By this civil application, the applicant seeks restoration of the second appeal which is dismissed in view of the conditional order passed by this Court on 15th September, 2015. 4. The applicant shall remove all the office objections, if any, within two weeks from today, failing which the civil application shall stand dismissed without further reference to the Court.

5. The civil application is accordingly disposed of in aforesaid terms. No order as to costs.
