1. At this stage, there is no case made out to interfere with the impugned order in exercise of extraordinary jurisdiction. The matter is already reached an advanced stage. However, if ultimately the proceedings are decided against the Petitioner and the Petitioner chooses to institute a substantive appeal, then, it will be open to the Petitioner to challenge the impugned order dated 25/08/2014 by resort to the provisions contained in Section 105 of the CPC or principles analogous thereto.
