After the matter was heard for some time on the request of the Petitioner to release the current account attached by the Respondents, by consent, following order is passed :

(a) The Petitioner will approach the Respondent no.1 or its duly authorized official and that would be to compute and quantify the dues which has been demanded from M/s.Smashing Traders Pvt.Ltd. After that dues is quantified together with interest, then, the amount so computed and quantified will stand attached only.
