2. Heard. This Petition is rather an unnecessary litigation. The petitioner is requested to attend a criminal case as a witness for the prosecution. The prosecution requested her to come and depose in respect of certain documents. It is the case of the prosecution that certain documents are with the petitioner's witness. Now, the case of the petitioner's witness is that she might willingly go and appear before the criminal court as a witness but she would not able to produce documents which are sought from her.
