2 This Application is preferred by the claimant for condonation of 3 years and 59 days delay in filing First Appeal challenging the award dated 16.07.2009 passed by the M.A.C.T. Niphad in M.A.C.P. No. 170 of 2005

3 The learned counsel for the respondent no.3 Insurance Co. vehemently opposed the present Civil Application. She submits that applicant has not shown sufficient cause for condonation of inordinate delay.

4 Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the Applicant and the reasons disclosed in paragraph 11, 12 and 13 of the Civil Application, I am satisfied that the Applicant has made out a case for allowing the present Civil Application. At the same time, applicant to pay cost of Rs.750/- to respondent no.1 and respondent no.3 within four weeks from today.

5 Hence, the following order:

i) Delay in preferring First Appeal is condoned.

ii) Applicant to pay cost of Rs.750/- each to respondent nos.1 and 3 within four weeks from today.

iii) Civil application stands disposed off accordingly.
