1. Since during the pendency of the petition, the Collector has granted the relief as prayed by the Petitioner, the writ petition practically has become infructuous. Secondly, during the pendency of the petition, certain subsequent events have taken place viz. the Commission -State Excise has stayed the order passed by the Collector, the learned counsel for the Petitioner, therefore, seeks leave to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to file an appropriate proceeding.
