After arguing this writ petition some time, Mr. Sawant on instructions from the petitioner's representative who is present in court seeks leave to withdraw the petition with liberty to approach the Customs, Excise and Service Tax Appellate Tribunal in a pending appeal and request it to grant such reliefs as are permissible in law so as to keep in abeyance the notice of demand issued by the Superintendent of Central Excise Department, Mumbai-I.
