This Petition was placed for admission today. Prayer clause

(a) of the Petition reads as under:-

“[a] This Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue a writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature thereof directing the High Power Committee to decide the Petitioner's plea for interim reliefs in Appeal No. 175 of 2014 expeditiously in accordance with law and preferably within a time-bound period as may be directed by this Hon'ble Court;”
