This Chamber Summons is taken out for amendment of the Petition. In the Petition, the Petitioner has challenged the collection of trade refuse charges by the Respondent-Corporation. The Respondent-Corporation in its reply has referred to certain Circulars revising the trade refuse charges. The amendment is in relation to the said Circulars.

2. Though the learned Counsel for the Respondent-Corporation has opposed the Chamber Summons, I am inclined to allow the Chamber Summons, as by the said Circulars the trade refuse charges have been revised by the Respondent-Corporation.
