1. By this notice of motion the petitioners seek condonation of delay of more than one year in filing the present petition. None appeared for the petitioners when the matter was called out. A perusal of the affidavit in support of the notice of motion indicates that it is the case of the petitioners that a copy of the award dated 29th January, 2010 was received by the petitioners, however, the petitioners were constantly negotiating for the settlement with

respondent No.1 and thus could not contact its advocate for preparing the present petition.
