1 Further to the order passed on 13.10.2015, the Court Receiver is present in court. According to the Court Receiver, the charges payable to the Court Receiver is Rs.33,950/- + Valuer's fees of Rs.9,528/- totaling to Rs.43,478/-. Against this, the Court Receiver has Rs.14,784/- to the credit to the plaintiff. Therefore the balance sum payable by the plaintiff to the Court Receiver is Rs.28,694/-. The counsel for the plaintiff states that the plaintiff will pay the said amount within four weeks from today.
