After arguing for some time, Mr. Jain appearing for the Petitioners seeks leave to withdraw the Writ Petition with liberty to amend the Complaint in the pending Civil Suit and implead all parties to this Writ Petition as party Defendants and seek such reliefs, finally as also interim, in the pending Civil Suit. However, he prays that for enabling him to take requisite steps and aforesaid the order passed in

this Writ Petition on 10th July, 2014 be continued for a period of four weeks from today.

2) We have heard the parties only on the point of continuation of the ad-interim order and we find that since the matter concerns the safety and security of public and particularly in the light of a emergency such as fire, it would not be appropriate to continue the ad-interim order as prayed for. We continue it for only a period of two weeks but without prejudice to the contentions and rights of all parties. The continuation of ad-interim order shall not be construed as our expression of opinion on the merits of the controversy.
