MINUTES OF THE ORDER

UPON the Application of the Applicant Company above named by a Company Summons for Direction **AND UPON HEARING** Mr. Hemant Sethi instructed by Hemant Sethi & Co., Advocates for the Applicant Company, **AND UPON READING** the Affidavit dated 4th day of June, 2015 of Mr. Ratish Arya, Authorised Signatory of the Applicant Company, in support of Company Summons for Direction, and the Exhibits there in referred to, **IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The convening and holding the meeting of the Equity Shareholders of the Applicant Company, for the purpose of considering and, if thought fit, approving, with or without modification(s), the proposed Scheme of Arrangement between Atlas Castalloy Limited with Alicon Castalloy Limited and their respective Shareholders and Creditors is dispensed with, in view of consent given by all the nine Equity Shareholders of the Applicant Company, which are annexed as Exhibits “**D-1**” to “**D-9**” to the Affidavit in support of the Company Summons for Direction. The Applicant Company undertakes to give individual notice by RPAD / Speed Post /

Airmail to Ms. Shefali Rai whose consent has been signed by her Constituted Attorney, of the date of hearing of the Petition.

The convening and holding the meeting of the Secured Creditors of the Applicant Company, for the purpose of considering and, if thought fit, approving, with or without modification(s), the proposed Scheme of Arrangement between Atlas Castalloy Limited and Alicon Castalloy Limited and their respective Shareholders and Creditors is dispensed with, in view of averments made in paragraph 13 of the Affidavit in support of Company Summons for Direction, inter alia stating that the present Scheme is an arrangement between the Applicant Company and its shareholders as contemplated under Section 391(1)(b) of the Act and not in accordance with the provisions of Section 391(1)(a) of the Act as there is no compromise and / or arrangement with the Secured Creditors as no sacrifice is called for and the rights of the Secured Creditors are not affected and there is no reduction in amounts payable to the Secured Creditors as no sacrifice is called for and that the Applicant undertakes to issue individual notice of the date of hearing of the Company Scheme Petition to all its Secured Creditors and also publish notices in 'Free Press Journal' in English language and translation thereof in 'Navshakti' in Marathi Language both having circulation in Mumbai. The convening and holding the meeting of the Unsecured Creditors of the Applicant Company, for the purpose of considering and, if thought fit, approving, with or without modification(s), the proposed Scheme of Arrangement between Atlas Castalloy Limited and Aicon Castalloy Limited and their respective Shareholders and Creditors is dispensed with, in view of averments made in paragraph 14 of the Affidavit in support of Company Summons for Direction, inter alia stating that the present Scheme is an arrangement between the Applicant Company and its shareholders as contemplated under Section 391(1)(b) of the Act and not in accordance with the provisions of Section 391(1)(a) of the Act as there is no compromise and / or arrangement with the Unsecured Creditors and that the Applicant Company undertakes to give individual notice of the date of hearing of the Company Scheme Petition by RPAD / Speed Post / Airmail to its Unsecured Creditors having an outstanding balance of Rs. 2.00 lakhs and above and also publish notices in 'Free Press Journal' in English language and translation thereof in 'Navshakti' in Marathi Language both having circulation in Mumbai. The said undertaking is accepted.
