By the impugned orders dated 20 March 2013 and 10 June 2014 passed by the Appellate Authority, the Petitioner's Application for Premises Licence under the Bombay Police Act to run a Video Game Parlour has been rejected.

2 Learned AGP, on instructions, states that the Application of the Petitioner for the said licence shall be considered afresh.

3 In the circumstances, the Petition is disposed of by passing the following order:

(i) The impugned orders dated 20 March 2013 and 10 June 2014 are set aside.

(ii) The Application of the Petitioner for Premises Licence to run a Video Game Parlour shall be considered afresh by the Respondent No.2.

(iii) Respondent No.2 shall decide the Application of the Petitioner afresh within a period of six weeks from today. While deciding the Application, the Respondent No.2 shall take into consideration the judgments cited by the Petitioner.
