(a) The Director of the Company will obtain Director's identification numbers and file all statutory returns including pending statutory returns and compliances electronically under the various provisions of the Companies Act, with the Registrar of Companies within a period of 12 weeks from the date of this order;

(b) The Company shall comply with Sections 266A to 266G,

159 to 162, 166, 210 and 220 of the Companies Act and to make an appropriate application under Section 621A of the Companies Act, for compounding the offences, if any,

(c) The Petitioner to pay costs of Rs.10,000/- to the Respondent.
