Learned counsel for the respondent states that the respondent would produce the originals of two documents described in prayer clause (a) before the learned arbitrator on 7th September, 2015 at 11:30 a.m. and all subsequent dates for cross-examination of R.W. 1. The statement is accepted. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondent, this Court need not pass any separate order as far as prayer clause (a) is concerned.
